ife during Lockdown Our Lenten Journey/Walk




Dear Saints,

Our Lenten Journey is an annual event which is central to the Life of the Church the body of Christ. Our Lenten Journey is about empowering us the body of Christ to be that visible presence of God's grace, mercy and love of God in the world today. It is therefor a time when we look at those areas of our lives, which prevent us from being effective agents of the Kingdom of God in the here and now. It is also a time when we critically reflect on the areas in our corporate lives as communities and nations which prevents us from creating a just and equitable world for all of us to live in. Here we particularly reflect on our own personal role in that which causes us to fall short of the glory of God.

Our Lenten walk through the western part of Africa towards Jerusalem exposes us to the joys and challenges of our fellow Africans. We will be looking and praying for the two key issues our Lenten programme is focussing on, moving towards human relationships that eradicate gender based violence and becoming a continent which is able to respond effectively to the deadly Covid-19 Pandemic.

Below you will find a list for this coming week of where we will find ourselves as we walk prayerfully. Please do not forget your daily reading from the Gospel according to St Mark, to guide our prayers and thoughts. May you have a powerful God encounter this coming week.

We started the Lenten Walk yesterday on Ash Wednesday, as we virtually walked as a collective from our church in Midrand through the North-West province to cross the border into Botswana.



Today we are walking through Botswana from the border town Lobatse to Phuduhudu. Tomorrow we continue to walk through Botswana to reach West Hanahai. On Saturday we cross the border from Botswana into Namibia to reach the town of Gobabis. On Sunday we rest.



Next week we continue our walk through Namibia, on Monday towards Okamatapati, on Tuesday towards Oshivelo and Wednesday we cross the border into Angola to reach the town of Evale.

As we walk let God's words to King Solomon ring through our ears and renew our minds

"14 if my people who are called by my name humble themselves, pray, seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land."

2 Chronicles 7:14


Remember that for every kilometre walked we ask you to donate 1 rand towards the Covid-19 relief programme of St Monnica's Outreach ministry. Encourage your friends and family members to join the Lenten walk or to sponsor you.

Besides the virtual pilgrimage to Jerusalem, we fast during Lent every Wednesday and Friday. On Wednesdays we break our fast at 18h00 with a service where we reflect on gender based violence. On Fridays we break our fast with a service where we reflect on the Stations of the Cross.

"Lord Jesus we desire oneness with you and our fellow human beings. Empower us through the presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives to be truly transformed and to be agents of transformation wherever we find ourselves."
